ALS 101

These classes address questions and connect recently diagnosed patients with programs and resources

SUPPORT GROUPS

These meetings are offered in many regions across Arizona, and are open to anyone impacted by ALS

CARE CONSULTS

Care Services Coordinators work with families to provide health education, emotional support, and assess needs

EQUIPMENT LOAN

Durable Medical Equipment ranging from \$25- \$30,000 is provided to patients in need through our Loan Closet at no cost

LIVING WITH ALS

This program provides fun, adaptive leisure activities that allow families to connect with peers in a non-threatening atmosphere

PATIENT COUNSELING

Counseling services are available to assist patients and their families with addressing the challenges of an ALS diagnosis

CERTIFIED CLINICS

Certified clinics provide a team of health care professionals specifically trained to address the needs of ALS patients in a single visit

TRANSPORTATION

Wheelchair accessible transportation to/from clinic appointments is available for patients that are unable to acquire an accessible vehicle

RESPIRATORY CONSULTS

Consultations with an ALS respiratory therapist are available on an as-needed basis in order to address questions about respiratory concerns

CHILDLIFE SPECIALIST

We provide families with age-appropriate counseling services to support youth facing the realities of their loved one's diagnosis

YOUTH PROGRAM

This program serves youth who have loved ones with ALS by providing fun events & enabling them to build connections with peers who understand their challenges

RESPIRE CARE

The Respite Care program provides breaks for family members who are giving constant care to their loved ones
